




Figure 3. Hurricane Ike losses paid by year separately for claims with lawsuits or letters of representation versus all other claims. Data is through October 15, 2012.






Figure 4. Cumulative Hurricane Ike losses paid as of the end of each year, separately for claims with lawsuits or letters of representation versus all other claims. Data is through October 15, 2012.
