REDISTRICTING

I believe the redistricting process should be centered on maintaining the character of communities to the maximum extent possible. Urban, suburban and rural. I live right on the eastern boundary of Burnet County. My next door subdivision neighbor is in Williamson County.

The differences between those two counties is extreme. Williamson is overwhelmingly suburban and Burnet is essentially rural with all that that implies.

I believe the redistricting process should be performed by elected officials who are accessible to and answerable to their constituents. Otherwise it would be a secret process susceptible to undisclosed and improper influences.

For obvious reasons, the redistricting process must be completed before the next election in 2022. As the process is underway, it would be counterproductive to publish interim maps or proposed boundary lines. Every effort must be made to avoid artificial delays and move the process forward as quickly as possible.
